PRIVACY POLICY AND PARTICIPATION AGREEMENT

QUEER PANDÈMIA - Artistic contaminations of an-other kind

1. We inform you, pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679, concerning the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data (hereinafter "**GDPR**") that the processing of data supplied by you with this admission form or annexed to the Application Form ("Application Form") or collected in any other way during the activities connected to the call "QUEER PANDÈMIA - Artistic contaminations of an-other kind", including your name and your image, will be based on principles of correctness, lawfulness and transparency and may also be carried out through automated methods designed to memorize, manage and transmit them and will take place using suitable tools, as far as is reasonable and in the state of the art, to ensure security and confidentiality through the use of appropriate procedures that avoid the risk of loss, unauthorized access, illicit use and dissemination.
2. The consideration for this release is the interest in participating in the call selection procedure and in the possibility of being published in the book **QUEER PANDÈMIA - Artistic contaminations of an-other kind** and the possibility of participating in a collective exhibition at BASE Milano.
3. **Data controller** is the TWM Factory Cultural Association, Via del Casale Bicocca 15, Rome, 00143, Italy in the person of the President Nicola Bruccoli, to whom you can contact to assert your rights as provided for in chapter III of the GDPR.
4. The data collected in the application process will be processed by TWM Factory, Ass.Cult., as data controller, for the following **purposes**: (i) management and documentation of your participation in the selection procedure of the form of public evidence and its possible subsequent assignment; (ii) transmission on the Internet, on video channels, social networks, on printed paper and/or any other channel and/or means of communication known today or developed in the future, for purposes of a communicational and promotional nature of the editorial product and subsequent editions of the same, or in any case relating to the use of the rights transferred with this admission form; (iii) sending promotional-advertising material from the organizer, including newsletters.
5. Your data will be entered into the database of the Association and employed for the aforementioned activities connected to the call and will be kept for the period strictly necessary for said operations, except in the case in which a longer retention term is required by law. After this term, such data will be destroyed or made anonymous. The data you provide may be communicated by us to any members of the candidates evaluation commission, as well as to other third-party companies that will treat them for the same purposes. Your data will not be transferred outside the European Union.

6. You may exercise at any time all the rights granted to the interested party, including the right of access to data, the right to update, rectify and delete data, integrate incomplete data, limit processing, to receive data in a structured format, commonly used and readable by an automatic device, to oppose all or part of the use of the Data, to lodge a complaint with the Authority, as well as to exercise the other rights granted to you by the applicable legislation. These rights can be exercised by writing by post to the address of TWM Factory, Via Giuseppe Arimondi 3, 00159 Rome, or by e-mail to info@twmfactory.it.
7. **The processing of your personal data is necessary to allow your participation in the selection procedure of the call QUEER PANDÈMIA - Artistic contaminations of an-other kind.** Therefore, the legal basis for the processing of your personal data is that referred to in art. 6, paragraph 1 lett. b) of the GDPR. Failure to provide the requested data will make it impossible to participate in the aforementioned selection procedure.
8. The submission of the application for the call QUEER PANDÈMIA - Artistic contaminations of an-other kind, via the application form on the website www.ultraqueer.it, and the receipt of the documentation required by the Call allows participation in the selection procedure for the call QUEER PANDÈMIA - Artistic contaminations of an-other kind in order to create an editorial product edited by TWM Factory.
9. **The documentation contained in the application form may be used for the purposes necessary for the selection procedure of the works and critical texts and for the operations connected to the same.** The selection procedure will be based solely on the evaluation of CV, portfolio, proposed work(s) and/or critical texts attached to the Application Form, and will be carried out by a special commission designated by TWM Factory. The selection will take place on the basis of the evaluation criteria specifically outlined in the Call for Participation and cannot be claimed in any way by the participants in the selection. Any other information attributable to your person will also be treated with the same methods and purposes as in point 1. The documentation will not be disclosed, modified, processed or published except for the purposes of the selection and only among the members of the jury decreed for the choice of the participants .
10. **The application for being admitted to the selection procedure can be submitted by completing and sending the Application Form in all its parts, together with all the documentation requested in the Call.** All the aforementioned documentation must be received no later than the delivery deadlines set out in the Call for Participation (see point 4), through the application form on the website www.ultraqueer.it; applications received after this deadline or in different ways will not be taken into consideration, unless otherwise optionally assessed by the organizing body.
11. Participants declare and guarantee that the artistic productions and written productions are the result of autonomous activity, do not violate intellectual property rights or any other right of third parties and that the content is not offensive, illicit, harmful, threatening, abusive, harassing, defamatory and/or libelous, harmful to the privacy of others, racist, classist or otherwise reprehensible. Applications for participation with such contents will not be taken into consideration, without prejudice to any other right and/or action. Consequently, the participants agree to indemnify and hold TWM Factory harmless, as well as

any entity or assignee of the same, from any obligation of compensation, including reasonable legal fees that may arise from the violation of third party rights or applicable laws attributable to the documentation sent, therein including their use for communication and promotional purposes of the Call.

12. The following document is governed by Italian law and any dispute relating to the same will be submitted to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court of Rome, Italy.
